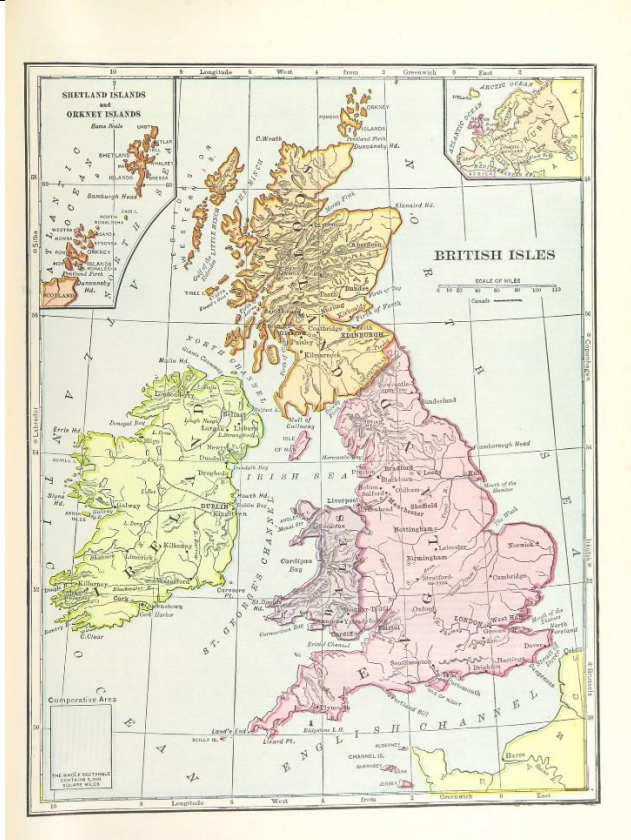


Our Country



Statutory Curriculum content

As Scientists we will

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

As Design Technologists we will

- Continue the Fabric Faces topic this half term.
- Use a template and fabric to develop masks.
- Discuss their ideas as they develop and say what their design has to do to achieve the design criteria.

As Geographer we will learn about

- The countries of the UK developing learning beyond children's immediate environment and own locality to the UK in general.
- The UK by looking at individual countries, capital cities, human and physical features along with comparing and contrasting the capital cities of London and Brasilia in detail.

As Computer scientists we will

- Develop our research skills using digital and non-digital sources
- Gain a deeper understanding of information sources including copyright and reliability.
- Use computer software to organise and present data and results
